After reading, locate the prompt that corresponds to your grade level, and write your response according to the instructions.

K - 4TH GRADE | How can kindness affect someone else or change a situation? Draw a picture or write a paragraph about a time when you were kind to someone or when someone was kind to you, and how the situation or relationship changed because of kindness.

5TH - 8TH GRADE | In this quote, William Saroyan suggests that approaching things with a positive attitude and acting with kindness toward others can change the world. Can our attitude and actions really affect what we experience in our lives? Write a 2-3 paragraph narrative on a time when your actions or attitude changed the outcome of a situation or had a positive impact on someone else.

9TH - 12TH GRADE | In this quote from his play "The Time of Your Life" William Saroyan explores the idea that our actions, expectations, and intentions can have a profound effect not only on our own happiness and success, but can also have the power to positively impact the world around us. How much can our actions and expectations affect the way we experience the world, and how much can these actions and expectations influence the behavior of others? Can kindness really change a world that can at times be divisive, violent, and hopeless? In a narrative essay of at least 750 words, describe how our actions, attitudes, and beliefs can influence the outcome of a situation or could have a positive impact on someone else. You can choose to reflect on a personal experience, or you can explore how the essence of Saroyan's words could apply to a situation you have witnessed in the world today.
